## **Implementation Date: November 10, 2023**

## **New Information**

This memo supersedes and obsoletes the VIN 2016–08 Salvage Pool Lien Sale memo. Salvage pools **cannot** conduct a lien sale to obtain title to a vehicle.

## **Procedures**

Follow regular procedures in processing lien sales. Lien sale paperwork that shows a salvage pool as the lienholder, **and** was started prior to November 10, 2023, will still be accepted. Salvage pools may continue to sell vehicles that went through a lien sale process prior to the salvage pool's possession.

## **Background**

The *Vehicle Industry Registration Procedures Manual*, Chapter 18, prohibits a salvage pool from conducting a lien sale to obtain title to a vehicle. The *Vehicle Code* (VC) defines salvage pools as businesses "exclusively" in the business of disposing of vehicles and not in the business of repairing, storing, or towing vehicles. Therefore, salvage pools cannot utilize lien sale processes described in the *Civil Code*. VC also prohibits salvage pools from selling a vehicle unless the sale is in conjunction with salvage or nonrepairable certificates.
